A WEEK OF ACTION, IDEAS, AND CONNECTION

From 22–26 April, Think & Act Differently, Powered by BHP brought its global innovation platform to life at Espacio Riesco in Chile. The team's presence was bold and intentional—designed to spark conversations and invite collaboration.

At the Think & Act Differently, Powered by BHP booth, visitors explored six live presentations, including:

- Three success stories of collaboration with startups and academia
- A showcase of the ASTER accelerator
- A deep mining innovation talk
- A live demonstration of the Open House platform—an always-on portal that invites innovators to submit ideas and guarantees a response

On the main stage of the Mining Pavilion, Think & Act Differently, Powered by BHP hosted two standout panels:

- Collaboration and Innovation for the Mining of the Future
- Creative Copper Recovery: Beyond Traditional Processes

These sessions brought together voices from across the ecosystem—entrepreneurs, researchers, and industry leaders—united by a shared belief that mining can be more sustainable, more inclusive, and more innovative.





WHO WE MET

The week was rich with connection.
Think & Act Differently, Powered by BHP engaged with:

- Startups and scaleups from across the region
- Academic institutions like
 Universidad de Concepción and T2CM-PUC
- Innovation hubs including Fundación Chile, CNP, and CIPTEMIN
- Delegations from Peru, Australia, and Canada
- **BHP teams** from innovation, procurement, and HR









At the booth's pitch station, over 235 people lined up to record their ideas for a better mining future.

Meanwhile, 74 rounds of speed mentoring gave innovators direct access to BHP specialists—offering feedback, encouragement, and potential pathways to collaboration.





A NIGHT TO REMEMBER: "GET INTO TAD, SANTIAGO 2025"

Midweek, Think & Act Differently, Powered by BHP hosted a side event at Fundación Chile. It was part celebration, part strategy session. With 89 attendees—including 40 innovators and 31 ecosystem leaders—the evening featured pitch sessions, roundtable discussions, and networking.

The goal?

To build trust, spark ideas, and lay the groundwork for long-term partnerships. And it worked. The energy in the room was electric, and the conversations continued long after the event ended.
